Paleontologists are scientists that dig up fossils or bones from millions of years ago! These bones belonged to dinosaurs.



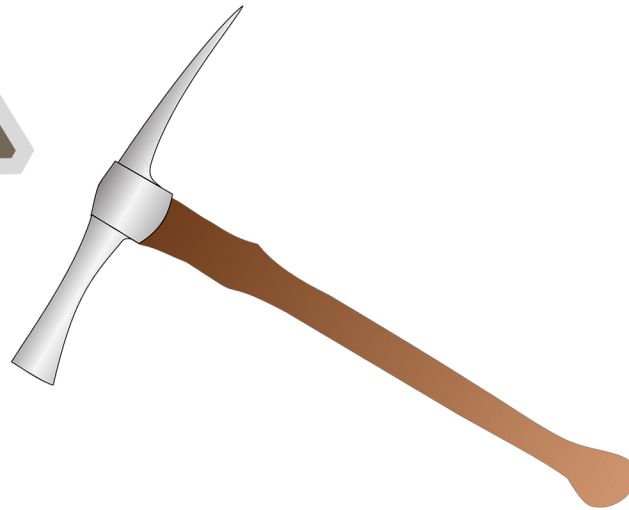
Dig Sites

Dig sites are where paleontologists have found fossils. One small fossil can reveal a whole dinosaur or other animal beneath the ground, like in the picture above.



Dig Site Grid

Paleontologists make grids on dig sites so they can remember where they found a fossil. Each square in the picture above is a section of the grid.



Tools

Paleontologists use tools like shovels, brushes, and picks to dig fossils out of the ground.
