Suggestions for Artifacts

Things to think about:

What would I want people to know about me if they found my time capsule in 2000 years?

How can artifacts tell others about my hobbies, memories, and friends/family/role models?

Specific Ideas:

- Item that represents your favorite activity or sport
 - Examples for artifacts: tennis racket, paint brush, basketball
- Item that represents your favorite subject to learn about
 - Examples for artifacts: numbers for math, book for reading
- Note with your favorite song
- Note with a current event that happened recently
- Note with a description or picture about people who are important in your life
- 3D replica of your pet
- An invention that was created during your lifetime (technology, tools, products)
- Picture of something cool you want to do in your life (a place you want to travel to)
- An invention that you would want to build



Instructions for Creating a Time Capsule

Your time capsule will need to survive a trip to space. In order for it to make it safely, your time capsule must:

- 1. Hold 3-5 artifacts
- 2. Have a way to easily access artifacts (have an opening so someone can reach in and take out artifacts to examine)
- 3. Have a sign on the outside of the container that says: Don't open until year 4,018
- 4. Have a way to be anchored to the ground so it doesn't float away due to gravity
