Hey! I am David. I am an orthopedist. Right now, I have two main parts of my job. First, I see patients who might have broken bones. I do an exam to determine if I think they have broken a bone. To do an exam, I carefully move a body part and see if the person has pain. I also do an Xray. Second, I research new materials that can be used to make casts. I work with engineers and doctors to figure out how to make strong casts for babies, children, and adults.

Planning Your Episode

Step 1: Write a description for your episode.

Step 2: Write a script with a short introduction, questions you will be asking the person you are interviewing, and a short conclusion.



Steps to Create a Youtube Channel

Step 1: Decide on audience for your channel

- The audience is the group of people who will be watching your channel.
- It is important to identify your audience so you can make sure the episodes on the channel will relate to the audience and be interesting to them.
- Examples of audiences: kids, teachers, scientists, people who live in Texas

Step 2: Create a name and description for your channel

- Choose a name for your channel that explains what the channel is about.
- You should also write a short description that explains what the channel is about so people can decide if they want to watch episodes on your channel.

Steps to Create an Episode for the Channel

Step 1: Write a description for the episode

- Write a short description that tells viewers what the episode is about.

Step 2: Create a script for the episode.

- Write a short introduction where you introduce the person you are interviewing. You should say the person's name, what his or her job is, and a few important details about what he or she does. You should look at the summary on the first page for information that you can include.
- Write 4-8 questions that you would want to ask the person you are interviewing.
- Write a short conclusion that thanks the person for being on the episode and tells viewers to check out other episodes.
