1. Describe the difference between a good and a service. Provide 1 example of each.

- A good is a physical product that people can buy and sell. Example: Toy
- A service is an action or an experience that people can purchase. Example: Tutoring

2. Give 2 reasons why a country may put an embargo on another country.

- They do not agree with how they treat their citizens.
- They have nuclear weapons that are a danger to the country.
- They harm animals and the environment.
- The goods or services they sell are not safe to use.

3. The U.S. has had an embargo against Cuba since 1958. U.S. businesses were not allowed to trade with Cuba. Cuba is a tiny island not far from the coast of Florida. Describe how an embargo such as this could affect people at a national and local level.

- National level: Create tension/fighting between Americans and Cubans; hurt businesses in both countries because they cannot sell their products or services to people in that countries.
- Local level: People in Cuba may not be able to get food or proper medical equipment that the U.S. could provide them.
