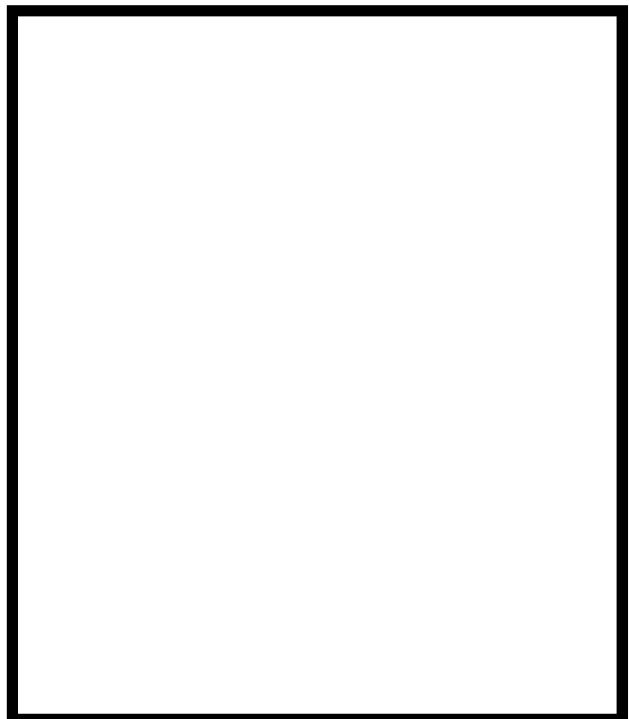
Step 4: Create Your Entry
