### 1. Explain why the U.S. government created posters during World War I.

To convince U.S. citizens to support the war.

### 2. What might have happened in the U.S. if women weren't encouraged to work while the men were at war?

**Answers may vary:** Women might not have worked in factories to make machines for war or plant gardens to help grow food.

### 3. Which group of people do you think were the most important for the U.S. government to target with posters? Explain your reasoning.

**Answers may vary:** Groups students may discuss include children, women, men, and people who didn't enlist.
