New Deal



A series of programs and projects that strived to create jobs and help Americans who were suffering.

Created and put into place during the Great Depression by President Franklin D. Roosevelt.

Great Depression



An economic downturn in the United States, lasting from 1929 to 1939. Began after the stock market crash of October, 1929, which caused banks to fail, people to become jobless and homeless and many to lose their farms.

Civilian Conservation Corps



A work relief program that employed millions of young men (ages 17-28) on environmental projects during the Great Depression created by FDR. It was one of the most successful New Deal programs.
