

Examples of Constellations



Name of Constellation: Pegasus

Name of Constellation: Cassiopeia

This constellation was named after a queen.





How to Create a Constellation

Step 1: Choose a constellation to make. You can choose one that you saw in the examples or you can design your own. If you design your own, you will decide what shape your constellation will look like.



Step 2: Build your constellation. Use the marshmallows as stars and the toothpicks as lines connecting the stars.



Step 3: Name your constellation. Write the name on your nameplate your teacher gives you.


