

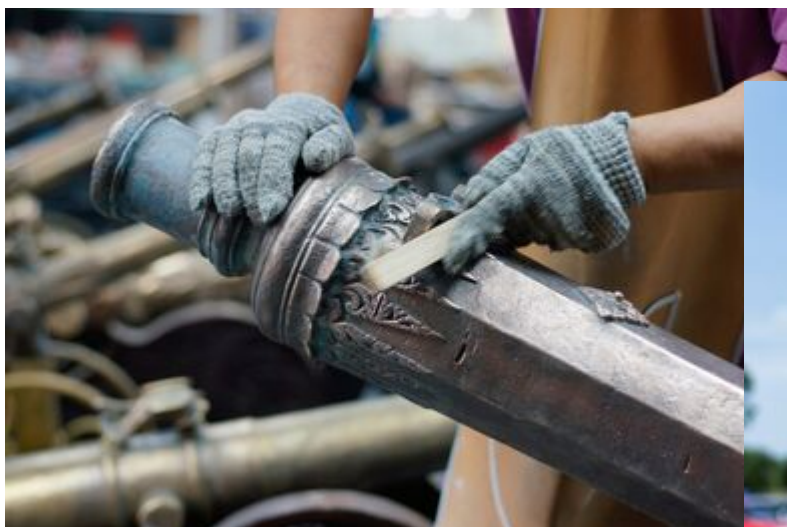
Example of an Artifact

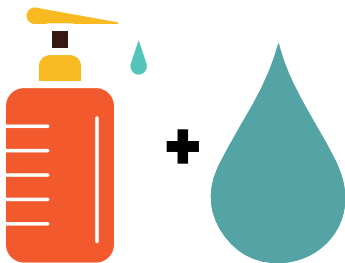

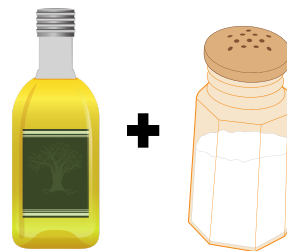
