4. Examine transnational issues such as counterterrorism, counter proliferation, and cyber security

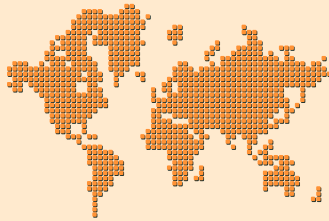
