Creating a Time Capsule
Have you ever seen a time capsule? A time capsule is a container that is filled with items that describe someone's life. For example, your time capsule might have a movie ticket stub, a tennis ball, a drawing of your favorite app, or a photograph of important people in your life. Once time capsules are created, they are hidden away for a certain amount of time. They are then opened at a later date. Some time capsules are opened hundreds of years later!
