

Being Unique-Teacher Tips

Teacher Tips:

1. If completing in the classroom, we recommend calling students up individually as the class is working to assist them with creating their fingerprints.
2. If you don't have ink pads, you can have students use non-toxic, washable paints. Have students put a small amount of paint on their finger and press it onto the page. To do this, make sure that students only use a small amount of paint and that it is evenly coated across the finger. There should be no blobs of paint!
3. You can also use pencil lead to make fingerprints. Have students color in a small patch with pencil lead. Then, have them roll the pad of their finger in the lead, coating their finger. Roll pad of finger on paper to create fingerprint.
