#### **Meet Lin!**

# Lin is a YouTuber. A YouTuber makes videos for people to watch!

Lin makes his YouTube videos about different holidays in America. Right now, Lin is making a video about a holiday called Labor Day. Labor Day is celebrated in the month of September.







In the first part of the video, Lin explains that the word "labor" means work. When teachers teach students, they are doing work! When doctors help patients who are sick, they are doing work. When people deliver your mail or packages, they are doing work!

## What is Labor Day?

In the next part of the video, Lin explains why Labor Day is a holiday in our country.

He explains that over one hundred years ago, many people worked in factories that were dirty and not safe to work in. Factories are places where products, like paper, shoes and clothes, are made. Most factories back then did not have fresh air, clean bathrooms, or safe machines.



Workers also had to work very long hours in factories. For example, they worked from 6 a.m. in the morning to 8 p.m. at night. That is a very long time to work!

Workers also did not get paid a lot of money. During the 1800s, factory workers were paid as low as \$1 per day!



### **Worker Treatment**

In the next part of the video, Lin explains that the workers were upset about how they were treated. They wanted to get paid more money and work in safer places.








On Tuesday, September 5th in 1882, the factory workers came together in New York City and created a group. This group was called a union.

The union went on strike. This means the factory workers stopped working. They also marched around the city to demand safer factories and better pay. Over 10,000 factory workers marched! Some of the factory workers even had a picnic in the park with their families after the march!

## **Making New Rules**





Finally, government leaders listened to the workers. They agreed to make new rules that would make the factories safer. The rules also said that people were not allowed to work such long hours and that workers had to be paid more money.





## **Celebrating Labor Day**

At the end of the video, Lin explains that people still celebrate Labor Day today. In 1894, Labor Day became a federal holiday. A federal holiday is a holiday that the United States government recognizes as an official holiday. Many adults do not have to work on Labor Day. Some people celebrate Labor Day by watching parades, going to cook-outs, and spending time with family. Lin explains that his favorite activity to do on Labor Day is go swimming with friends and family!







When Lin is done recording all of the parts of his Labor Day video, he uses his iPad to put them together. He also adds music and special effects. This is called editing.



Lin is ready to put his video to YouTube! He hopes that it will teach people all about Labor Day.
