



Constitution Day is a special day in the United States. It is celebrated every year on September 17th.

On this day, we learn about the Constitution. The Constitution is a special piece of paper. It describes all of the rules that our government must follow. It also explains what freedoms people have in our country.

Learning about Constitution Day

The Constitution was written over 200 years ago! It was written by a group of leaders who did not like the rules in our country. They decided to make new rules! These rules are written and explained in the Constitution.



One rule in the Constitution is that people have rights. A right is a kind of freedom. It is something that all people are born with in our country. A right cannot be taken away.

For example, the Constitution says all people have the right to practice any religion. This means that you can go to any church, mosque, or temple to pray. No one can take away this right.



The Constitution also says that all adults have the right to vote. This means that adults can give their opinion on who they want to be our leaders of the United States. No one can take away this right.

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Learning about Constitution Day

Take a closer look at the Constitution! At the very top, it says, “We the People of the United States.” This means that the Constitution is for all people who live in the United States!



In the middle of the Constitution, there is a long list of all the different rules for the government and the people to follow.



The bottom of the document has the names of the people who wrote the Constitution.
