Answer Key to Questions in Step 1:

- 1. British immigrants moved to Kansas because the cities in England were overcrowded and because droughts made it difficult to grow enough food.
- 2. Both the Italian immigrants and the Mexican immigrants struggled to find jobs in their home countries and came to Kansas to find more opportunities for work.
